Welcome to Year3. I hope you all had an enjoyable and restful holiday. I am looking forward to working with your children this year and have a lot of exciting activities planned for this year. Here is an overview of all the topics planned for this half term in each of the curriculum areas.

Topic

Our Literacy will be taught through our topics, so our Literacy focus is Being Healthy and Animals. We will be reading *The Hodgeheg*. We will be writing stories, diaries, adverts and recounts.



R.E. Topic

Our topics for this half term are Homes and Promises. We will then be studying *Judaism*, with a special focus on the Synagogue, next half term.



Science

We will be studying Animals including Humans with a focus on the skeleton and healthy eating.

ICT

The children will start the year by using Bug Club and Timestables Rockstars. We will then quickly move onto improving their wordprocessing skills.



P.E.



P.E. will be on Wednesdays. Please ensure your child's kit is labelled and in school for the whole half term. Remember children come into school in their uniform and change for PE in the classroom.

Swimming: Please ensure your child's swimming kit is clearly labelled. You must ensure your child has a swimming hat, goggles and swimming costume/trunks (no Bermuda shorts). Swimming is on Monday afternoons. Please make sure the bag is big enough to fit in all their clothes and towel as we do not leave anything in the changing room during the lesson.



Reading

Reading is very important and in Year 3 we focus on comprehension skills as well as fluency. Please try and hear your child read regularly, asking them questions about the text and any vocabulary they are unsure of. There will be books on Bug Club fortnightly.

Spelling

Your child will receive spellings in their Link Book on Fridays. We will be working on these spelling patterns and words from the Y3/4 spelling list regularly in class. There will be a test each Friday.

Homework

Homework will be sent home on a Friday to be returned by the following Wednesday.
